### **How it Works**

- 1. Parental Consent: Obtain permission for your child to be virtually evaluated by a CCMC provider.
- 2. Virtual Conference: The school nurse connects your child with a CCMC provider.
- 3. Assessment: Thorough evaluation conducted with the support of the school nurse.
- 4. Follow-up Care: Instructions and prescriptions sent to your preferred pharmacy, with delivery options available.
- 5. Record Keeping: Visit records stored for future reference, with copies sent to your primary care physician.
